

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR ASSEMBLY

- Files with illustrations of the house and with the address book
- Vinyl glue
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape
- Magnetic tape
- One 4-digit padlock
- Two 3-digit padlock
- One directional padlock
- Four small brackets
- Invisible-ink pen with UV light
- One bell
- One magnifying glass

It is recommended to print on card paper.

We recommend putting labels on each padlock so that it will be easier to re-assemble the game after use. For example, attach an adhesive label with the word "FRIDGE" on the padlock that keeps the fridge closed.

INSTRUCTIONS BOX 1 (ENTRANCE&LIVING ROOM)

- 1) Cut out illustration 1;
 - fold it in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 1A into square 1 of the box (see scale model of the box).
- 2) Cut out illustration 1C and paste it on the back of 1B.
- 3) Cut out illustration 2;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 2A into square 2 of the box.
- 4) Cut out illustration 2C and paste it on the back of 2B.
- 5) Cut out illustration 3;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 3A into square 3 of the box.
- 6) Cut out illustration 3C and paste on the back of 3B.
- 7) Cut out illustration 4;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 4A into square 4 of the box.
- 8) Cut out illustration 4C and paste it on the back of 4B;
 - Using a cutter, cut out the space in the upper right corner where you see the scissors symbol.
- 9) Cut out illustration 5A and paste into square 5 of the box (center square).
- 10) Cut out figure 5B and fold along the dotted lines;
 - glue 1 on top of 2 and 3 so as to create an envelope;
 - glue the envelope to the center of illustration 5A.
- 11) Cut out figure 5C and insert the message into the envelope created above (5B).
- 12) Cut out 1D and 1E and paste only the tabs into the corresponding spaces in Illustration 1A and 1B.
- 13) Cut out 2D;
 - cut out the dotted circles with the cutter;

- glue a strip of adhesive magnetic tape to the back (top);
- glue a strip of magnetic tape of the same length also on the aquarium present in illustration 2B;
- join the two magnetized parts together.
- 14) Cut out figure 2E and paste it on the corresponding space in illustration 2A;
- Cut out along the dotted lines Figure 2F and glue only the tab above the tab in Fig. 2E;
- cut out along the dotted lines figure 2G and glue only the tab over the tab in fig. 2F;
- cut out along the dotted lines figure 2H and glue only the tab above the tab in fig. 2G.
- 15) Cut out Figure 4D, fold the tabs and glue the parts with dashed outlines into the corresponding space in Illustration 4.
- 16) Cut out the food cards (4E) along the continuous line (scissors icon);
- fold each card in half following the dotted line;
- glue front and back so that one side of the card shows the product illustration and the other side shows the name of the product and expiry date;
- insert the food cards into the Market envelope (Illustration 4A).
- 17) Using double-sided tape, attach a bracket for the padlock in the space provided (square with X);
- close the illustration by passing the hook through the openings and insert the 4-digit padlock by setting the code **1819** (to set the combination follow the padlock instructions).
- 18) Cut out illustrations 6 and 7 and keep aside (laminating is recommended), they will be needed during the game.

INSTRUCTIONS BOX 2 (KITCHEN)

- 1) Cut out illustration 1;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 1A into square 1 of the box.
 - 2) Cut out illustration 1C and paste on the back of 1B;
 - using the cutter, cut out the rectangle dotted with the scissors symbol.
 - 3) Cut out illustration 2;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 2A into square 2 of the box.
 - 4) Cut out illustration 2C and paste on the back of 2B.
 - 5) Cut out illustration 3;
 - fold in half as if it were a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 3A into square 3 of the box.
 - 6) Cut out illustration 3C and paste on the back of 3B.
 - 7) Cut out illustration 4A and paste into square 4 of the box.
 - 8) Cut out illustration 5A and paste into square 5 of the box (center square).
 - 9) Cut out Figure 5B and fold along the dashed lines;
 - glue 1 on top of 2 and 3 to create an envelope;
 - Glue the envelope to the center of illustration 5.
 - 10) Cut out Figure 5C and insert the message into the envelope.
 - 11) Cut out illustration 1D (fridge doors) and fold the dashed flaps;
 - Glue only the flaps into the corresponding spaces in illustration 1.
 - 12) Cut out the individual food cards (fig. 1E) and insert them into the fridge compartments.
- ATTENTION: Distribute in a disorder manner, disregarding the labeling of the compartments.
- 13) Cut out Figure 1G and fold, following the dotted lines (illustrations towards outwards);
 - glue the two sides together and insert the card into the Meat compartment (it should be the first card visible to the players).

- 14) Using double-sided tape, attach the padlock bracket to the corresponding space in illustration 1;
- close the fridge and put on it the 3-digit padlock with the code **180** (to set the combination follow the instructions of the padlock).
- 15) Cut out figure 1F and fold following the dotted lines;
- Glue in the corresponding space on the fridge door (illustration 1C).
- 16) Cut out the individual recycling bins (Fig. 2D) and fold the dotted flaps;
- glue only the flaps into the space provided in illustration 2.
- 17) Cut out figures 3D - 3E - 3F and fold the dotted flaps;
- Glue only the flaps into the corresponding spaces in illustration 3.
- 18) Cut out the individual food cards (fig. 3G) following the continuous lines (scissors symbol);
- fold each card in half, following the dotted line (illustrations towards outwards);
- glue the two sides so that on one side you can see the picture of the product and on the other the name and expiry date;
- place the products in the compartments (fig. 3D- 3E- 3F). Attention: Distribute in disorder, disregarding the labeling of the compartments.
- 19) Cut out figure 3H;
- fold in half and glue the two sides together;
- paste into the corresponding space in illustration 3C.
- 20) Cut out the pages of the cookbook (Figures 4B);
- Glue the pages on top of each other (just the flaps);
- paste the cookbook in the space provided in illustration 4.
- 21) Cut out Figure 4C and with the cutter, cut out the dotted circle;
- Glue only the flap over the cookbook pages to create the cover.
- 22) Cut out Figure 4D and fold following the dotted line (illustrations towards outwards);
- glue the two sides together and use the cutter to cut out the dotted circles;
- take a piece of ribbon or string to attach the message to the cookbook cover (pass the string or the ribbon through the cut-out circles of the message and of the cookbook cover).

BOX 3 INSTRUCTIONS (BEDROOM/BATHROOM)

- 1) Cut out illustration 1;
- fold in half as if it were a book (illustrated part inside);
- Glue part 1A into square 1 of the box.
- 2) Cut out illustration 1C and paste on the back of 1B.
- 3) Cut out illustration 2;
- fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
- Glue part 2A into square 2 of the box.
- 4) Cut out illustration 2C and paste on the back of 2B.
- 5) Cut out illustration 3;
- fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
- Glue part 3A into square 3 of the box.
- 6) Cut out illustration 3C and paste on the back of 3B.
- 7) Cut out illustration 4;
- fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
- Glue part 4A into square 4 of the box.
- 8) Cut out illustration 4C and paste on the back of 4B;
- Cut out with the cutter the dotted rectangle where the scissors symbol is drawn.
- 9) Using double-sided tape, attach the padlock bracket in the space provided;

- close the page and put the 3-digit padlock with the code **530** (to set the combination, follow the padlock instructions).
- 10) Cut out illustration 5A and paste into square 5 of the box (center square).
- 11) Cut out Figure 5B and fold along the dotted lines;
 - glue 1 on top of 2 and 3 to create an envelope;
 - Glue the envelope to the center of illustration 5.
- 12) Cut out Figure 5C and insert the message into the envelope (Illustration 5).
- 13) Cut out the 1D illustration and construct the envelope;
 - paste into the space provided in illustration 1.
- 14) Cut out figure 1E;
 - fold in half (illustration towards outwards) and glue the two sides together;
 - fold and insert the card into the envelope (fig. 1D).
- 15) Cut out the 2D figure and fold the flaps along the dotted lines;
 - Glue only the flaps into the corresponding space in ill. 2 so as to create a pocket in which to insert the cards with the clothes.
- 16) Cut out illustration 2E and fold the flap along the dotted line;
 - glue only the flap into the corresponding space in illustration 2 to create the cabinet door.
- 17) Cut out the cards with the clothes (fig. 2F) along the continuous lines (scissors symbol);
 - fold each card following the dotted line and keeping the illustrations facing outwards;
 - glue the two sides so that the image of the clothes is visible on one side and the relevant information on the other;
 - place all the cards with clothes inside the closet (fig. 2D).
- 18) Cut out the 3D figure and paste only the flap into the corresponding space in illustration 3.
- 19) Cut out Figure 3E and paste only the flap into the corresponding space in Illustration 3.
- 20) Cut out figure 3F;
 - fold the written message and paste it on the back of the washing machine;
 - paste only the flap into the corresponding space in illustration 3.
- 21) Cut out Figure 4D and paste only the flap (dotted line) into the corresponding space in Illustration 4C so as to hide the safe design.

INSTRUCTIONS BOX 4 (GARAGE)

- 1) Cut out illustration 1;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 1A into square 1 of the box.
- 2) Cut out illustration 1C and paste on the back of 1B.
- 3) Cut out illustration 2;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 2A into square 2 of the box.
- 4) Cut out illustration 2C and paste on the back of 2B.
- 5) Cut out illustration 3;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 3A into square 3 of the box.
- 6) Cut out illustration 3C and paste on the back of 3B.
- 7) Cut out illustration 4;
 - fold in half as if it was a book (illustrated part inside);
 - Glue part 4A into square 4 of the box.
- 8) Cut out illustration 4C and paste on the back of 4B;

- Use the cutter to cut out the dotted rectangle where the scissors symbol is drawn.
- 9) Using double-sided tape, attach the hook for the padlock in the space provided;
- close the page and put the directional padlock with the code **UP - DOWN - RIGHT - LEFT** (to set the combination follow the padlock instructions).
- 10) Cut out illustration 5A and paste into square 5 of the box (center square).
- 11) Cut out Figure 5B and fold along the dotted lines;
 - glue 1 on top of 2 and 3 to create an envelope;
 - glue the envelope to the center of illustration 5.
- 12) Cut out Figure 5C and insert the message into the envelope (Fig. 5B).
- 13) Cut out figures 1D - 1E - 1F - 1G and glue only the flaps in the respective spaces in illustration 1.
- 14) Use the Invisible-ink pen to write inside the cloud the sentence, "**What tools are needed to fix the wheel on the bicycle?**" Participants will only be able to read the sentence by illuminating it with the pen's light.
- 15) Cut out figures 2D and 2E and fold the flaps along the dotted line;
 - glue only the flaps into the corresponding spaces in illustration 2 so as to create the toolbox where the cards can be stored.
- 16) Cut out the tool cards (fig. 2F) along the continuous lines;
 - fold each card along the dotted line, keeping the illustrations facing towards outwards;
 - glue the two sides of the cards so that one side shows the tool and the other side shows part of the compass;
 - insert the tool cards into the tool box.
- 17) Cut out the map (fig. 3D) and paste into illustration 3. ATTENTION: Fold inwards the part of the map that remains outside the illustration.

COVERS' INSTRUCTIONS (ATTIC PARTY)

- 1) Cut out figure 6A and glue it inside the cover of the entrance/living room box;
- 2) Cut out figure 6B and glue it inside the cover of the kitchen box;
- 3) Cut out Figure 6C and glue it inside the cover of the bedroom/bathroom box;
- 4) Cut out figure 6D and glue it inside the cover of the garage box.

ADDRESS BOOK INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Cut out each page of the address book.
- 2) In each page cut out the gray strip under the letter.
- 3) Assemble the address book by gluing the pages together in alphabetical order. The first page is the one showing instructions on how to use the address book; the second page is the one showing emergency numbers. Attention! Glue only the left column.
